



SYLLABUS

Group A: Class 3rd-6th

Level 1: The syllabus is equivalent to junior level of Basic Astronomy. There will be greater emphasis on study of Our Solar System i.e. Sun, Moon and Planets.

Level 2: Basic Astronomy, Current affairs of Astronomy and General knowledge (Astronomy only).

Group B: Class 7th-9th

Level 1: The syllabus is equivalent to senior level of Astronomy. There will be greater emphasis on study of Ancient Astronomy, Our solar system, BIG-BANG theory, Space Missions, Black Holes, Stars, and Asteroids & Comet.

Level 2: Basic Astronomy, Current affairs of Astronomy and General knowledge (Astronomy only).

Group C: Class 10th-12th

Level 1: The syllabus is equivalent to senior level of Astronomy. There will be greater emphasis on study of Modern Astronomy, Rockets, Space Agencies, Gravitational Waves & Gravity, Virtual-Reality, Black Holes, Stars, and Worm Holes.

Level 2: Basic Astronomy, Current affairs of Astronomy and General knowledge (Astronomy only).
